**This is included:**

- All daytime support services for adults in Manchester who have social care support. Typically, this means provision for groups of adults, usually in a fixed setting, and includes all providers, including council run services.
- young people moving from children to adult services.

**This is not included:**

- Services to individual adults such as homecare or personal assistants; provision that takes place solely for the residents of a care home or supported living setting.
