### Terms and conditions for activities for families with children and young people with send in summer 2022

I understand that all terms and conditions for the trips and activities booked must be adhered to by all the people in the family group I have booked for.

I understand that if terms and conditions are not met, in full, by all group members then we may all be excluded from activities and any payments or deposits will not be refundable.

- The booking must be for a family who live within the Manchester City Council boundary and include at least one child aged 17 or under with special educational needs or a disability this is a requirement of our funding.
- At the booking days you can only book 1 trip and/or 1 activity day from the 'trips and activities' list—participants can access other Local Offer / Short Breaks services via the Manchester City Council website. <a href="https://www.manchester.gov.uk/sendlocaloffer">www.manchester.gov.uk/sendlocaloffer</a>
- You are responsible for ensuring that your group arrives on time for departure at all times.
- The coach will leave the departure point on time—you are responsible for travel home at your own expense if you miss the coach. In an emergency please contact the 4CT office on 0161 230 1420. Please store this number in your mobile phone

#### Please be aware:

- The coach has storage for prams / buggies / wheelchairs you cannot take these on board
- No eating / drinking on the coach please
- There is one fixed wheelchair space on the coach (that can stay on the coach) so if you need this please tell us in advance—via the booking form.
- Most of our departure venues have a small car park—if you need to use nearby on street parking
  please park responsibly and be aware of any cost involved in using local car parks. Broadhurst has
  no car parking but the neighbouring FC United site has a car park—again please check terms and
  conditions.
- The packed lunch for the trips consists of a drink, sandwich, fruit and a nut-free cereal bar. Due to numbers we can only offer two sandwich types. If you have special dietary needs you are advised to bring your own lunch / snacks etc.
- All trips are transport only—with the exception of the Children's Adventure Farm Trust which includes admission. You are responsible for any additional activity costs during your trip.
